

Course	Requirements
History/Social Science	One year World History, one year US History, one year Government/Economics (a one semester personal finance class can substitute for Economics, starting with Class of 2031).
English	Must include a study of classic and modern literature from both American and foreign authors, as well as essay writing.
Mathematics	Must include one year of Algebra 1.
Science	Choose two of these four classes: Physical Science, Biology, Chemistry, Physics. At least one of these must include lab assignments.
Foreign Language	Any language other than English. All units must be from the same language.
Bible	Two semesters of a Bible based class. Can include Christian Worldview, Apologetics, Old/New Testament, Life of Jesus, or other Christian course.
Physical Education	Can be fulfilled by 200 minutes per week of organized team sports, recreational classes, or an exercise log. A health class is also accepted.
Visual/Performing Arts	Choose from the following: Dance, Music, Theater, or Visual Arts.
Electives	Can include any extra classes from the above categories, as well as other classes that interest the student.
Ethnic Studies	Starting with the graduating class of 2030, students must take a one semester course in ethnic studies. If ethnic studies is actively included in one of your other classes, this will fulfill the requirement.
